3.1. Level of qualification:

Bachelor' degree. Bachelor' degree is awarded to a person who has the general secondary education or vocational secondary education. Bachelor' degree is a necessary condition for admission to receiving of the Master's degree.

3.2. Official length of programme:

Five years or 208 weeks: 142 weeks of the theoretical courses (lectures, seminars, laboratory works), 8 weeks of practice, 16 weeks for examinations, 2 weeks final State attestation, 2 weeks final qualifying work, 38 weeks of vacations. The total credit hours of the educational professional load is 230 credit hours of ECTS.

4.2. Programme requirements:

Bachelor of Economics should:

- have a systematic understanding of structures and trends of the development of the Kyrgyz Republic and World Economies;
- understand the diversity of economic processes in the modern world, their relations with the other processes occurring in the society;
- have the theoretical basis and principles of functioning of National Economy including the specific features of Transitional Economy;
- know the principles of managerial organizational decisions making and implementation;
- be able to identify the problems of economic, organizational and psychological nature when analyzing of the situations, to offer ways of their solving and assess expected results;
- classify and generalize information, prepare certificates and reviews of professional activity, edit and review texts;
- be able to use basic and special methods of analysis of economic and managerial information in the sphere of professional activity;
- develop and justify the options of efficient managerial decisions;
- assess (industrial, motivational, institutional) behavior of economic agents critically from different sides, trends of the development of objects in the sphere of professional activity;
- use computer technologies to solve economic problems;
- know the special economic and managerial terms and vocabulary of the major at least in one foreign language (English);
- possess skills of independent mastering of new knowledge using modern educational technologies;
- possess skills of professional argumentation when analyzing standard situations in the sphere of future economic activity.

4.4. Grading scheme and grade distribution guidance:

Grading is based on the State four-mark grading scale:

- The «EXCELLENT» mark is given for remarkable result with some unimportant incompletes.
- The «GOOD» mark is given to a student, who has good results in spite of some incompletes.
- The «SATISFACTORY» mark means conscientious result but with some serious incompletes in the theoretical grounding of a student.
- The «UNSATISFACTORY» mark is the result which corresponds to minimally possible criteria but with the right of passing the discipline again. The additional work for receiving a credit is necessary.
- The «PASSED» mark is given to a student, if he/she has attended a course in a full volume in accordance with the State Educational Standard and has an ability to apply the received knowledge in practice.

8. INFORMATION ON THE NATIONAL HIGHER EDUCATION SYSTEM

8.1. Description of the National system of higher education of the Kyrgyz Republic:

The Kyrgyz Higher Education system consists of the following High Institutions:

1. The Universities, which:

- implement programs of higher education, undergraduate and postgraduate, in different fields;

- carry out fundamental and applied research on a wide range of issues;
- prepare, train, retrain and ensure professional development, and also prepare scientists and scientific-researchers (candidates and doctors of sciences);
- constitute a scientific and methodological center in different fields.

2. The Academies, which:

- implement programs of higher education, undergraduate and postgraduate in its field of scientific activity;
- carry out fundamental and applied research on a wide range of issues;
- prepare, train, retrain and ensure professional development, and also prepare scientists and scientific-researchers (candidates and doctors of sciences);

3. The Institutes are the structural subdivisions of the University or Academy, which:

- implement programs of higher education and educational programs for undergraduates;
- prepare, train, retrain, and ensure professional development of workers with higher education;
- prepare scientific and scientific-research pedagogical personnel for certain sphere of professional activity;
- carry out some fundamental and applied researches of fundamental and applied character, according to the specialists' prepared profile.

4. The Specialized Institutes (conservatories, specific purpose institutes), which:

- implement programs of higher and postgraduate education;
- prepare, train, retrain, ensure professional development, and also prepare scientific and scientific-research pedagogical personnel for certain sphere of professional activity;
- carry out applied scientific researches.

8.2. Educational and professional programs and awarded qualifications:

Higher education institutes of the Kyrgyz Republic conduct education according to the following educational professional programs:

- Bachelor's degree. Apprenticeship: 4-5 years. To get a Bachelor's degree one needs to pass the final state examination and defend a Bachelor's thesis.
- Master's degree. Apprenticeship: 2-3 years. To get a Master's degree one needs to pass the final state examination and defend a Master's thesis.
- Specialist's qualification. Apprenticeship: 5-6 years. To get a Specialist's qualification one needs to pass the final state examination and defend a thesis paper.
- Postgraduate degree. Master and Specialist has the right to enter postgraduate courses. Apprenticeship: 3-4 years. The education ends with the defending of Scientific thesis conferring to Ph.D. or Candidate's degree.
- Doctor's degree. Apprenticeship: 3 years. Ph.D. holders with practical work experience have the right to enter Doctor's degree courses. The education for Doctor's degree ends with the defending of a Doctoral thesis conferring to Doctor's degree.

8.3. License and attestation of the educational professional programs:

Institutes of higher education should have a license of Ministry of Education and Science of the Kyrgyz Republic to implement the educational activity in order to realize educational professional programs of different levels.
